## Chester County Amateur Radio Club By-Laws

- I. Secretary. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep the constitution and By-Laws of the club and have the same with him/her at every meeting. He/she shall note all amendments, changes and additions on the constitution and shall permit it to be consulted by members upon request.
- 2. Membership. Membership is open to licensed amateurs and anyone interested in Ham Radio, electronics and electronic communications. Membership includes all club privileges as well as rights to hold a club office and to vote at business meetings.

Applications for membership shall be submitted at regular meetings at which time they shall be reviewed by the President, or his/her representative.

Any member shall be removed from the club roster: either by mutual agreement between the member and the membership, or by a quorum vote of the membership at a meeting called by the President.

- 3. Meetings. Regular meetings shall be held at the appointed time as designated by the President. The President upon the written request of any club member may call special meetings. Notices shall be sent to members concerning special meetings and the business to be transacted. Only such business as designated shall be transacted. Such notices shall be sent so that they arrive not less than 24 hours before the meeting.
- 4. Dues. An annual assessment of \$20.00 per year for Primary Membership and \$10.00 per year for each additional Family Household Member.
- 5. The President shall appoint special committees to recommend and/or oversee special club functions throughout the year.
